## ORDINANCE SNAPSHOT 13.0502. Certain practices declared nuisances.

It is hereby determined that the following conditions tend to result in blighted and deteriorated neighborhoods, increase in criminal activity, spread of vermin and disease and are contrary to the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare to the community.



- (a) Storing or permitting the storage of accumulation of trash or rubbish.
- (b) Storing or permitting the storage or accumulation of junk, junk automobiles or abandoned vehicles on any private property within the city, except with in a completely enclosed building
- (c) Dismantling, cutting up, removing parts or otherwise disassembling any automobile, whether it is a junk automobile, abandoned vehicle or any appliance or machinery, except in a completely enclosed building.
